### Stewardship Reflection

"And Peter said to them, 'Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ..." Acts 2:38

The word "repent" means to turn from  $\sin$  - to change our thoughts, words and actions. Change that is permanent comes from within — a transformation or conversion of heart.
