



May is the month of Mary Queen of Heaven and Earth. During the month, in honour of Mary our mother, we will celebrate Flores de Mayo (Flowers of May). Starting May 5th and continuing each Sunday of the Month of May, we will have a procession. The words 'Ave Maria' will begin this procession followed by any parishioner who chooses to bring flowers to the foot of the statue of Mary. The flowers may be from your garden or purchased. They may be potted or fresh cut. When you arrive on Sunday with your gift of flowers, please wait at the back of the church for Father and the altar servers to process in with them. Thank you!

Everyone is invited to participate each Sunday of May. We will begin 15 minutes before mass starts. Please join us for the prayers. You are also invited to bring flowers from your garden or from the store, and join the special procession before mass begins, placing your flowers at the statue of Mary our mother.
